Harry and Harley, pictured on the front of this postcard, were born at 22 weeks and five days.

The latest guidance from the British Association of Perinatal Medicine enables doctors to intervene to save premature babies like Harry and Harley from 22 weeks. Research indicates that a significant number of babies born at 22 or 23 weeks gestation can now survive outside the womb.

This leaves a real contradiction in British law. In one room of a hospital, doctors could be working to save a baby born alive at 22 or 23 weeks whilst, in another room of that same hospital, a doctor could perform an abortion that would end the life of a baby at the same age.

Our 24-week abortion time limit is out of step with the majority of European Union countries, where the most common time limit for abortion on demand or broad social grounds is 12 weeks gestation.

The majority of the British population support reducing the time limit. Polling from ComRes has shown that 70% of British women favour a reduction in the time limit from 24 weeks to 20 weeks or below.
